



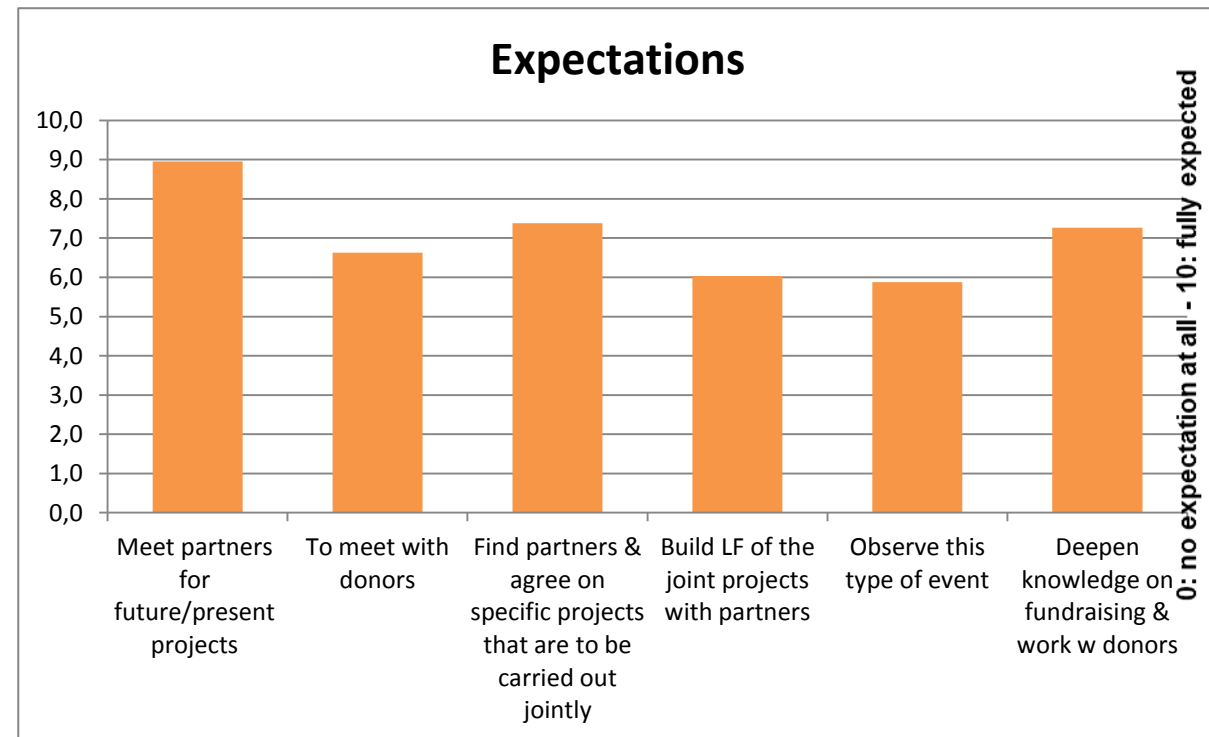
## TRIALOG Partnership Fair 2015: Evaluation Summary

The TRIALOG Partnership Fair, 4-6 May 2015 in Vienna gathered 95 participants from 26 countries; 56 EU13 participants, 33 EU15 participants and 6 participants from Western Balkans (Albania, Kosovo, FYR Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia).

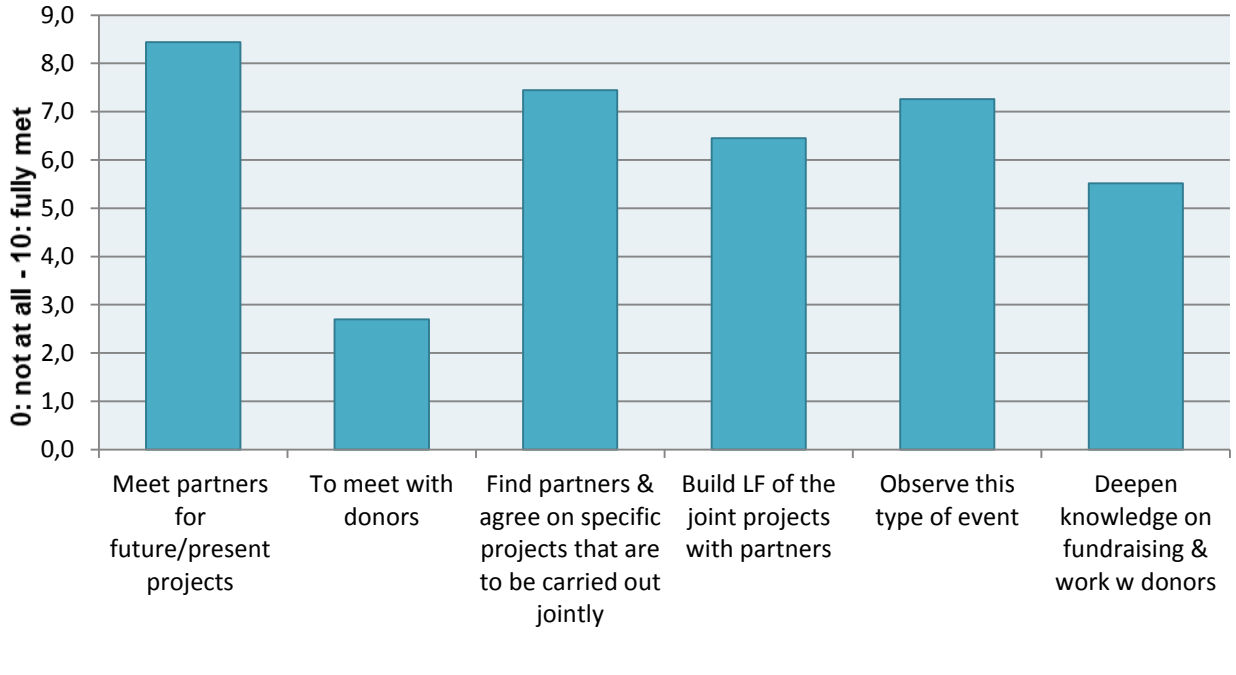
This evaluation is the result of feedback received from evaluation questionnaires handed out at the end of the fair. Out of 100 participants, we received 66 evaluations. The results are given to the nearest decimal place.

Regarding participants' expectations, meeting partners for future or current projects was rated highest followed by finding partners and going into more detailed project planning. Deepening knowledge on fundraising and meeting donors was also a popular expectation.

The overall level of satisfaction with the event was rated as good (7.7). 88 per cent of the respondents found partners to work with on future joint projects whereas the number of partners found varied greatly; from one to over ten.



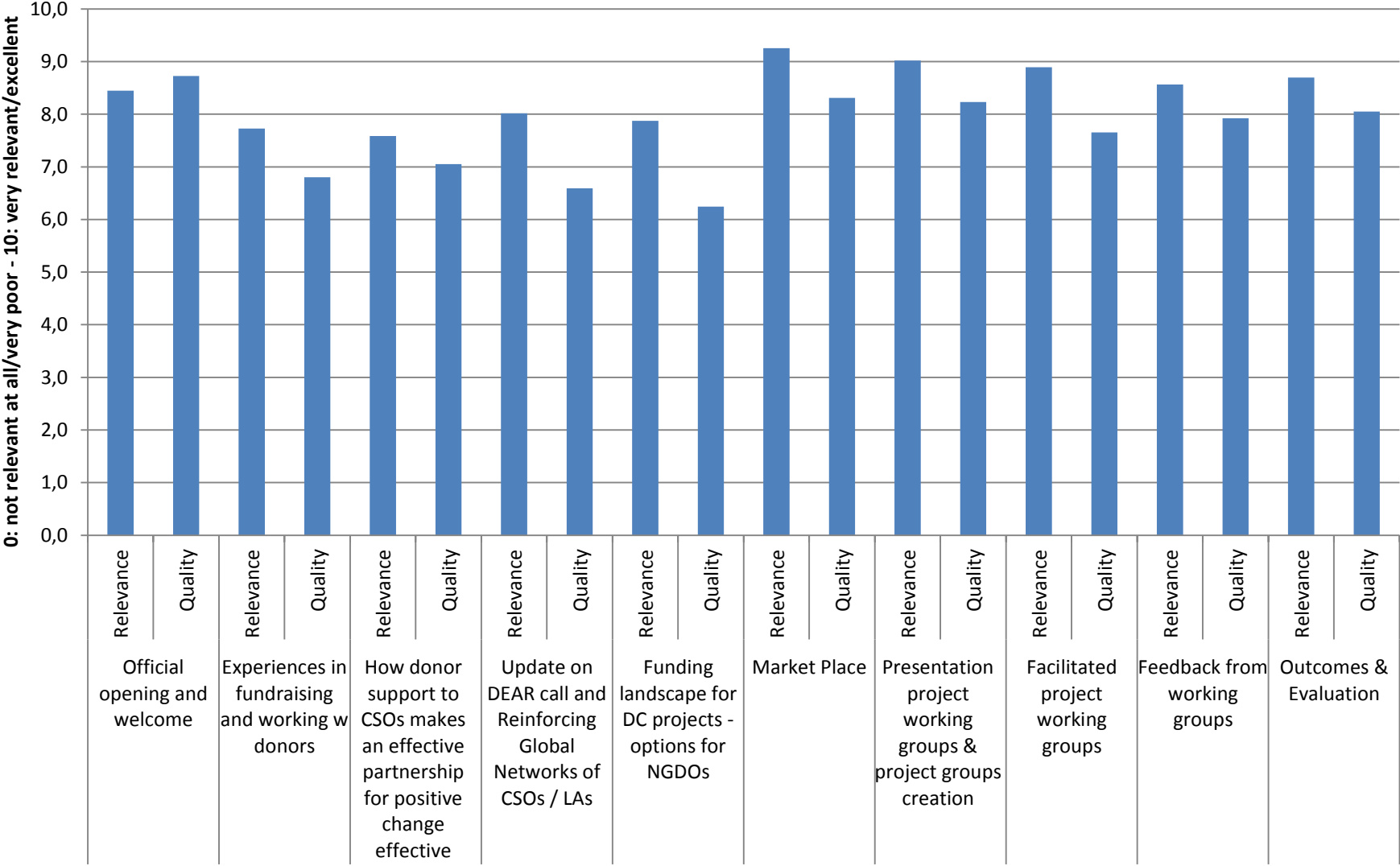
### To what extent were expectations met?



When asking to what extent participants' expectations had been met, meeting and finding partners ranked highest, whereas many respondents were frustrated by the low attendance of donors. This was also the main recommendation for improvement of the fair: to attract more donors.

# Programme Elements





Logistical support before and during the event as well as the venue, meals and accommodation all ranked very high with more than 9 out of 10 points awarded on average.

Almost all respondents would recommend the Partnership Fair to others. Many expressed their satisfaction that the fair provides an important opportunity for networking, finding partners, and sharing ideas and many were surprised about the fact that within a very brief period of time such concrete project ideas could take shape.
